Travel

Make sure you have secure arrangements for travel (crate/carrier bag)

Travel with one other person who will be able to sit next to the travel crate in the back and comfort the puppy during the journey

Avoid bringing very young children; if this is your first visit to the breeder's premises, avoid bringing any children in case you need to walk away

Breeder

Should update you on your puppy's health tests and vet check

Advise on when vaccination/worming is due

Explain type of food puppy is weaned onto, feeding amount and schedule

Demonstrate grooming tasks, dental hygiene, nail trimming

Provide information on socialisation and exercise

Advise on toilet training

Advise about puppy's night time routine

Go through the contract with you and make sure you understand all sections and any special points

Offer to register your puppy for 5 weeks free insurance

Advise how to transfer ownership with Kennel Club and microchip database
